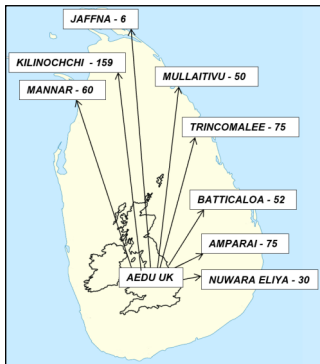

The map below shows all the Sri Lankan AEDU organisations with the number of children educated at each location as of June 2022.

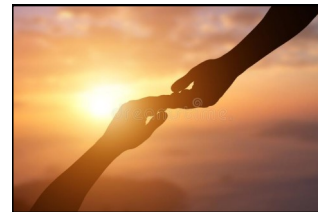


Increased Remittance; a helping hand

Due to the ongoing Covid and economic challenges in Sri Lanka, the AEDU UK committee has agreed to increase the monthly remittance from Rs.3,000 to Rs.4,000 for the months of June, July and August.

This will be reviewed at each quarterly meeting.

Health Care Assistant (HCA) Training Programme

After a series of delays due to the Covid pandemic, we are delighted to be supporting 14 AEDU school leavers on a Health Care Assistant (HCA) training programme. This is a 10 month course at Kurukkalmadam. The attendees will gain recognised accreditation, opportunities for employment and prospects for further training as nurses and midwives.

This is a joint venture with our sister charity organisation ADVRO who will also be supporting 14 other school leavers from their side.

Online English classes for the HCA students have already started and are being delivered by AEDU UK. They will continue to run in parallel to the HCA course.

The HCA training programme will start in Summer 2022.
